

Briarcliffe Swim COVID-19 Update – May 25, 2020

Dear Briarcliffe Member Families,

Happy Memorial Day from the Briarcliffe Board of Directors! On Friday, Governor Tom Wolf announced that all counties that are in red are expected to move to yellow by June 5th. Due to this announcement, the Briarcliffe Board of Directors has sent a tentative full-time opening date of Saturday June 6th barring any major issues. Since we plan to open full-time a week earlier, this will make up for the loss days from the delayed opening.

The Briarcliffe Board of Directors continues to monitor the situation and review all necessary material put out by the state of Pennsylvania and the CDC. Please note that this summer will not look like summers of the past. We will be adhering to state guidelines and CDC regulations for aquatic venues. There will be some changes to adhere to the social distancing guidelines and meet the necessary requirements. One example is that the snack bar will be open for takeout, there will not be dining permitted on the patio. The grounds and pools will also be setup to adhere to social distancing regulations. More information regarding guidelines will be released at a later date. We thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation, as we try to provide a summer experience for families while keeping our patrons and staff as safe as possible.
